



Westerland 2005 Sauvignon Blanc

Varietal: Sauvignon Blanc
Vintage: 2005
Origin: Coastal

Terroir:
Trellised vines on a south facing slope. Altitude of 150m creates good air circulation to cool down the vineyards.

Vineyard type: Trellised, dry land.

Yield: 7.5 t/ha

Balling at harvest: 21.5 °B

Vinification:
Wine made reductive to retain flavors. A low juice extract during pressing to prevent excessive phenol extraction. Cold fermentation with immediate reducing off the lees after fermentation.

Winemaker comments:
Hints of passion fruit makes for an interesting bouquet. Palate is fresh with surprising length which makes for an enjoyable experience.
