



Westerland Cabernet Sauvignon 2004

Cultivar: Cabernet Sauvignon
Vintage: 2004
Origin: Coastal

Terroir:

Warmer sites are selected to give full ripe grapes with dark color and soft tannins. Decomposed granite and Hutton in the area surrounding Darling hills.

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, dry land.

Yield: 6-7 t/ha

Balling at harvest: 24-25 °B

Vinification: Crush and destalk, 16 days fermentation at 22-28°C.

Maturation: The wine was matured with French oak staves for 3 months.

Wine makers comments:

Deep, dark color with aromas of blackcurrants. A great concentration of fruit on the palate supported with finely balanced tannins. A wonderfully soft and smooth finish. Enjoy until 2007.
