



## Westerland 2006 Celebration Red

**Varietals:** Cabernet Sauvignon (50%)  
Old-Vine Cinsault (30 – 35 yr old vines, dry land farmed)(50%)  
**Vintage:** 2006  
**Origin:** Coastal

**Terroir:**  
Decomposed granite and Hutton in the area surrounding Darling hills. Hot summers moderated by cool Atlantic.

**Vineyard type:** Bush Vine, dry land.

**Yield:** 6-8 t/ha

**Balling at harvest:** 23°B

**Vinification:** Crush and destalk, 10 days fermentation at 22°C.

**Maturation:**  
Maturation in stainless steel tanks with French oak staves for complexity.

**Winemaker comments:**  
Medium bodied with a deep ruby color, this is a generous and fruity blend exploding with aromas of dark forest fruit and mocha. A soft and appealing palate displays traces of cassis and blackberries. A wine to be enjoyed now and for the next year or two.
