



Westerland Pinotage 2005

Cultivar: Pinotage
Vintage: 2005
Origin: Coastal

Terroir:

Deep, decomposed granite soils on the slopes of the Darling hills, with a cooling effect in the warm afternoons from the Atlantic Ocean in close proximity.

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, dry land

Yield: 3-4t/ha

Balling at harvest: 25.5°B

Vinification: Crush and destalk, 10 days fermentation at 28°C.

Maturation:

The wine was matured with French oak staves for 3 months.

Wine makers comments:

A concentrated, fruity Pinotage with a touch of oak. Some spice on the nose as well as an abundance of small red berries. Smooth, full-bodied palate of generous richness and mouth feel. Enjoy for the next 5 years.
