



Westerland Unwooded Chardonnay 2005

Cultivar: Chardonnay
Vintage: 2005
Origin: Coastal

Terroir:

Trellised vines on an east facing slope; planted close to the valley floor for cold temperatures in the winter months.

Vineyard type: Trellised, dry land.

Yield: 9 t/ha

Balling at harvest: 22 °B

Vinification:

No skin contact after destemming, cold fermentation at 13°C to achieve a crisp palate and distinct varietal aromas.

Maturation:

Aging on the fermentation lease for one month to improve complexity and structure of the wine. No barrel aging.

Wine makers comments:

The wine is showing a clean bouquet of lemon and lime aromas. Has a good balance on the palate as a result of the high acidity in the wine.
